

Basic Kinesiology Practitioner Training

Welcome to the **Basic Kinesiology Practitioner Training** with the **NK Institute**. This training is made up of 10 Kinesiology Workshops requiring physical attendance, the completion of 6 *Units of Competency* and 50 hours of *clinical practice* (20 hrs supervised and 30 hrs mentored)

This certification unique to the *NK Institute* is designed to be completed in 1.5 years. After the first year of training you will be supported to gain Kinesiology Intermediate Practitioner status with the **Australian Kinesiology Association (AKA)**.

The Basic Kinesiology Practitioner Training includes attendance at practical kinesiology workshops, units of competency workbooks & assessments and 50 hours of clinical practice:

Breakdown of Training costs:

- The non-refundable enrolment fee of \$200, this will be invoiced after pre-enrolment is received
- 5 units of competency workbooks in the Basic Kinesiology Practitioner Training are \$200 each (\$1,000)
- \$100 each for units of competency assessment tasks (\$500)
- \$100 each for units of competency RPL assessment (\$500)
- \$0 for each unit of competency that is Credit Transferred
- Workbooks will be invoiced at \$300 each to include the assessment
- Supervised & mentored Practical Training cost of \$720 will be invoiced once in September of the enrolment year

This fee does not include:

- Any extra class time associated with the units of competency
- Any extra supervision costs
- Any kind of extra balancing tools (tuning forks, coloured light kits, slide sets etc)
